

**Providing rotary pile foundation for Construction of Sree Padmanabha
Block for Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan Senior Secondary School at
Kodunganoor, Trivandrum**

TENDER NOTICE

Tenders in sealed covers superscribed “Tender for Rotary Pile foundation to the school Building at Bhavan’s Kodunganoor school campus, Trivandrum” will be received at Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan’s Kendra Office, Kattu Road, Trivandrum, up to 3.00 PM on 11.09.2026

1. The tender should be submitted in the prescribed form which can be obtained from the office of **Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan’s Kendra Office, Kattu Road, Trivandrum** on payment of **Rs.1,500/-** [Rupees Thousand Five Hundred only]. The time allowed for completing the work will be Four [4] months. The tender documents will be available at our office from 31.08.26 and may be collected during office hours.
2. If the tender is made by an individual, it shall be signed by his full name and his address shall be given. In the event of the tender being submitted by a registered partnership firm, it must be signed individually by each partner thereof. In the event of absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by person holding a proper power of attorney authorizing him to do so and to bind the partner in all matters pertaining to the contract including the arbitration clause, such power of attorney to be attached with the tender which must disclose that the firm is duly registered under Indian Partnership Act. If the tender is made by a Limited Company, it shall be signed by a duly authorized person who shall produce with the tender satisfactory evidence of the authorization. In the case of a Limited Company the tender should be accompanied by the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.
3. Each tender should be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit amounting to Rs. 1,50,000/- [Rupees one Lakhs Fifty Thousand only] Only in the form of Demand Draft from a Scheduled Bank, drawn in favour of **The Secretary Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Trivandrum.**
4. The acceptance of a tender will rest with the Owner who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason.
5. The Owner or his duly authorized representative will open the tenders. In the event of a tender being rejected, the earnest money paid with such unaccepted tender shall be refunded to the tenderer.
6. The tenderer should keep open the validity of the tender normally for **Seven** days from the date fixed for its opening. However, it is also obligatory for the tenderer to keep the validity open for another **Five** days for which request in writing / telegram by the Owner before the expiry of the original validity would be sufficient intimation.

The receipt of the intimation from the Owner should be acknowledged by the tenderer. Should the tenderer withdraw his tender before these periods the earnest money deposited by the tenderer shall be forfeited.

7. The bidder shall quote the rate as a percentage above, below or at par with the estimated rate. The rate shall be quoted both in figures and in words at the space given space only and it should clearly be written by hand. The rates should be written legibly and free from erasures and over-writings or corrections of figures. Correction wherever unavoidable should be duly attested by the signature(s) of the tenderer(s) with dates.
8. The tenderer shall visit the site of work in order to acquaint himself with the condition of the site, the locality and its environments.
9. The tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of all documents, site etc., whether he has inspected them or not. The submission of a tender by tenderer implies that he has read this notice and general conditions of contract and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications and other factors bearing on the tender. The work and materials as per this tender are based on Indian Standard Specifications. Detailed bore log report of the site are attached with this tender. Contractor should have thorough knowledge of the soil strata and depth of pile to be reached. Rate quoted by the tenderer shall be for the total length of pile irrespective of its length variation.
10. The successful tenderer will be required to execute an agreement at his expense on Stamp Paper worth Rs 200/- as per the Standard Local Practice within seven days of acceptance of his tender for the due and proper fulfillment of the contract.
11. Failure to comply with conditions 7, 10, & 12 above will entail forfeiture of the earnest money.
12. The tenderer must furnish proof of his financial stability to execute the contract upto the limit of tender by a certificate from the Revenue Authorities. Otherwise, he should specify any scheduled bank to which the Owner can make reference regarding the tenderer's financial status.
13. The tenderer must also furnish evidence of his experience in similar work and his capacity to execute the work upto the limit specified in tender schedule by certificates from responsible officers under whom he has executed similar contracts if required by the Owner. For the purpose of evaluation, the tenderer shall submit the following in two separate sealed covers:

Cover 1 -Experience & Technical Details:

This cover shall contain details of the tenderer's previous experience in similar works, work orders, completion certificates, details of works executed, and other documents establishing his technical experience and capacity.

Cover 2 -Tender Documents:

This cover shall contain the duly filled and signed tender documents, including the Tender Schedule, BOQ/Price Schedule and other documents specifically required to be submitted along with the tender.

14. The tenderer shall clearly mark the two covers as “Experience & Technical Details” and “Tender Documents”, respectively.
15. Tenders which do not fulfill all or any of the above conditions or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be summarily rejected.
16. Canvassing in connection with the tender is strictly prohibited and tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
17. GST as per the rules / directions of the Income Tax Department prevailing in force at the time of payment of bills will be deducted while making payment or when crediting the amount to his / their account. Any stipulation by a tenderer that Income Tax deductible from these bills should be borne by the Owner will result in the summary rejection of his / their tender.
18. This tender notice shall form part of the contract.
